

Permanent locking pins

If you'd like to wear your restraints all the time, we offer a set of permanent locking pins which replace the Screw-Lock to make them unremovable without cutting the strap. We don't recommend these for collars. If you'd like them in future, you can get them via our shop anytime; each set comes with 5 permanent pins.

If you want to install permanent locking pins, install your cuffs as normal, and instead of installing the Screw-Lock into the locking clasp, put a single drop of cyanoacrylate (super) glue into the clasp's locking post, and gently press in a locking post. Once you're happy with its placement, firmly press down on the permanent pin for one minute, then allow the glue to cure for an hour.

You should wear your cuffs for a period of time before using permanent locking pins on them, to ensure the fit is comfortable and they don't interfere with your daily life. If you do install permanent locking pins, the cuffs will not be removable without cutting the Biothane® band. If you do need to cut a cuff band to remove it after installing permanent locking pins, this is not covered by our warranty.



BeltBolt ⚡ Cuffs & Collars Instructions for use

Thank you for your purchase of our Screw-Lock cuffs and collars! This booklet contains the information you need to use and take care of your restraints.

Putting on your restraints



You will need your included Screw-Lock key.

All our Screw-Lock keys are compatible with all Screw-Lock restraints. You should keep your key somewhere safe.



Use your key to unscrew the Screw-Lock in each restraint. You can then insert the free end of the restraint strap into the open slot on the locking clasp. Once you seat the strap into the clasp and the holes align, you can use your key to install the Screw-Lock fully, tightening it to hand tight only.

Remove your restraint by unscrewing the lock and pulling out the free end of the strap.

When not wearing your restraints, you should reinstall each Screw-Lock in every restraint to keep them safe. You can install them without closing or assembling the restraint, if you prefer to store them flat.



Taking care of your restraints

Our restraints and accessories are waterproof and suitable for almost anything you'd put yourself through, so have fun! You can clean them with soap and water, shampoo or anything you wash yourself with. Biothane® is extremely tough, and won't retain smells - it made its name in the pet and equestrian industries for a reason! So, don't worry about spilling anything weird on it that you're putting on yourself. Our locking clasps and other plastic parts are made from ABS plastic, which is very tough and resists most chemicals, but keep it away from nail polish remover (acetone). That's what made them shiny in our workshop, but it will eat through them too!

Safety

Most of our restraints are designed for everyday wear, to be comfortable and low-profile. They're capable of what we describe as "medium-scale debauchery", meaning they can be used with confidence in most common restraint scenarios. The limit of what our restraints can do is mostly down to how wide the Biothane® bands are (thin bands put more pressure on your skin) and how strong our locking clasps are. Unless we make something special, custom just for you, our restraints are not designed for extreme weight-bearing or suspension. Please practice safe kink and test your restraints before throwing them into extreme scenarios. Biothane® is extraordinarily strong, but our clasps are designed to break under extreme loads for safety. If you need to remove your restraints urgently, cutting is usually the fastest way out, just like rope bondage.

Spare parts & upgrades

If you need to check if your existing restraints are compatible with certain parts, check the listings or contact us anytime.

Need to change your sizing?

If you've ordered some custom non-adjustable restraints and you think you've got your size wrong, let us know and we can help you correct this. We can resize your restraints for a small fee (only materials costs if we need to cut new straps), and if your Biothane® straps are over 1.5cm too long, we can also provide instructions on how to shorten them yourself if you prefer.

How we make our restraints

Our restraint clasps and other hardware are designed in 3D and then sent to a 3D printer, where they are made as strong as possible, fully solid and configured to ensure they'll stand up to daily use. If we're making hardware which includes D-rings, we stop the printer at a specific layer to insert them directly into the print, trapping them permanently and making them hugely strong for their size. Every step after this is fully by hand. We then expose the locking clasps and other plastic hardware to a careful vapour treatment process which fully smooths the surface and removes printing artifacts, while also more than quadrupling the strength. We then leave these parts to slowly cure at room temperature under a gentle breeze, resulting in a medium gloss finish. Once fully hardened, we check everything for fit and finish, and move to cut the strapping. We use custom jigs and measurement apparatus to ensure we get our sizes as close to what you specify as possible. Once cut, we punch holes and round the free ends, and then add any required hardware to the Biothane® straps before sealing any punched holes and ends with a specialist gloop to keep water out permanently. Once the strap sealant cures, we put everything together and check for fit and finish.

Since our restraints are processed and finished by hand, you may notice some small differences between pieces, especially in white and light coloured plastics. While we remove the vast majority, you may notice some slight swarf or plastic film on metal D-rings where they enter the clasps. This will gradually come off in time, but we're careful not to scratch your clasps when putting them together, and due to how tight our tolerances are to get that nice tactile feel in your hand, sometimes we can't get everything off before shipping. It's harmless and merely a manufacturing artifact.

Warranty & returns

Our products are supplied in compliance with UK consumer protection law, and we'll replace faulty parts at no cost up to 1 year after delivery. If you ordered fully custom items designed just for you, we provide a more limited warranty of 6 months, covering manufacturing defects only.

If you wish to return your items, please contact us. All our made-to-measure products are considered bespoke and not eligible for a broad return policy, but we'll do what we can to make you happy!
